

POLICY NO: 16

POLICY ON PREFECTS/GAMES COMMITTEE/STUDENT COUNCIL AND MENTORS.

Aims:

- To afford students the opportunity to play an active part in the corporate life of the school
- To improve communications at all levels between staff, students and parents
- To help create the conditions necessary to develop interpersonal skills.

Implementation:

- Mentors are responsible for helping 1st years orienteer around the school in the 1st few weeks of Term 1. They organise lunchtime clubs on Fridays, which are open to all 1st years.
- Mentors have their own meetings.
- Student Council will be formed encompassing representatives from the entire student body. A teacher will facilitate and assist with organisation. Prefects, Games Committees will be formed to assist in the running of the school. They will meet regularly.
- Prefects and Games Committee introduce themselves to Junior students at Assembly and tell them what their function is and what their tasks are.
- The Principal will be invited to meetings.

Monitoring:

- Monitored on a regular basis by organising teacher.
- Feedback to staff at staff meetings.
